Old Business Items:

Shawn made a motion to Approve the last meeting minutes and the Work Session minutes, Kris Second, all in favor, none opposed.

Correspondence:

The Health Department contacted the Commission via e-mail requesting an update and possible walk through of the Elliott Park kitchen.

New Business:

The Commission carefully reviewed all of the old park rules and made the following decisions for the new park signs;

Park Hours Sign:

Park Open May-October 7:00am-9:00pm

November-April 7:00am-6:00pm

Children under 9 years of age must be accompanied by person 12 years of age or older.

Park Rules Wording:

- 1 No pets allowed except service animals.
- 2 No littering, graffiti or tagging.
- 3 No abusive, threatening or obscene language.
- 4 No drugs, alcohol or smoking.
- 5 Bicycles, skateboards, skates permitted in Skatepark only.
6. No camping.
- 7 BBQ permitted, No open flame.
- 8 Beverages in glass containers Prohibited.
- 9 No overnight parking.
- 10 Use playground equipment at own risk.

New Business continued:

Skatepark Rules Wording:

- 1 Skatepark users must adhere to all public park rules.
- 2 Helmet required 15 years and under, protective equipment strongly recommended for all users.
- 3 Children under 9 years of age must be accompanied by person 12 years of age or older.
- 4 Use Skatepark at your own risk.

Mini Park-Loy will check mini-park at night to ensure the light on the flag is on. It was recommended that all members view the park, mini park and pocket park after dark. Juan asked Commission to think up new names for the pocket park to present at next meeting.

The Commission will ask the City Council for permission to look for a covered bus station shelter for purchase.
