New Business: The Park flooded February 06th 2020. Juan reported that the State Investigators were here this week to assess the damage. Flood damage to the park is significant and the park will be closed. Permission to remove the log jam from the creek was granted as long as the equipment used stays out of the water. Erosion to the skate park footings/foundation is extensive and the skate park is closed until further notice. The fence surrounding the East side fell over due to the flooding. Emergency Management will issue safety inspections to all seven of the bridges in Weston.

FEMA requests will need to be started over.

Parks and Rec will be asking City Council for permission to purchase a pallet of 50 T-Posts, three rolls of hog wire and safety wire ties to close off the park to the public. Loy will measure the length of the area needed to be fenced and Annie will get the cost of the needed supplies to complete
