Minutes

November 04, 2019

The Commission met 6:30 pm at the City Hall. Present were; Chair-Juan Avila, Vice Chair-Loy Knutzen, Secretary-Kris Rasmussen, Council Liaison- Shawn Monaco and WCDC Liaison-Jim Davis.

Not in Attendance were; First Alternate-Joy Hearn (Excused) and Second Alternate Annie Davis (Excused).

Meeting was called to Order at 6:30 pm by Juan.

Old Business Items:

Loy made a motion to approve the last meeting minutes, Shawn second, all in favor, none opposed.

Park signs – Kris gave Shawn the current information for the signs.

Correspondence:

The Health Department contacted the Commission via e-mail requesting an update and possible walk through of the Elliott Park kitchen. Kris Rasmussen contacted via e-mail. Ongoing.

New Business:

Juan reported that he had six separate meetings with FEMA, to include a site inspection. FEMA approved 75% of the total costs to be covered to include 1000 feet of sewage line. The city will be responsible for the remaining 25%.

Four projects were approved during the site inspection; 1. Debris removal/to include white goods. 2. Have two remaining man holes wrapped. 3. Sewage line. 4. Restoration of park bank, to include Broad and Main Street Bridge.

Jim proposed to name the Pocket Park the “Bob Humbert Memorial Park”. Loy motioned, Kris second, all in favor none opposed. The name will be presented to the Council for approval on November 13 2019 at the City Council meeting.

Shawn will get quotes for the new park signs to present to the City Council.

The Commissioners set a new date for the next meeting.
