Old Business Items:

Annie made a motion to approve the last meeting minutes, Loy second, all in favor, none opposed.

Correspondence:

The Health Department contacted the Commission via e-mail requesting an update and possible walk through of the Elliott Park kitchen. Kris Rasmussen contacted via e-mail. Ongoing.

New Business:

FEMA Request – July 24 Weston received a Disaster Relief number from Langston Walker (FEMA Liaison). The site inspection is scheduled to occur between October 20-26.

Grant Award; \$1500.00 was awarded to the park by Pacific Power and Light on September 17. Laurie presented the check to the Vice Chair.

The grant from Blue Mountain Community Foundation for \$20,00.00 to upgrade the park kitchen and to make the park ADA compliant was denied.

The old stumps at Elliott Memorial Park have been ground and removed. The areas affected have been seeded over. The cost to rent the stump grinder was \$199.00, however the charged total was \$249.00. A follow up call will ensue to correct the overcharge.

WPRC welcomed Jim Davis as the new Liaison from the WCDC.

Shawn will get quotes for the new park signs to present to the City Council.
