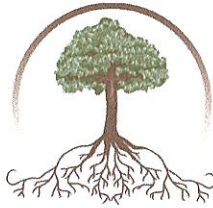


# Weston Parks & Recreation Commission

The Committee will meet at 1:30 pm at the kitchen of Saturday August 07<sup>th</sup>.

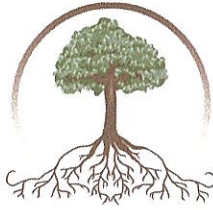
